## **1st World Championship of Street Magicians**

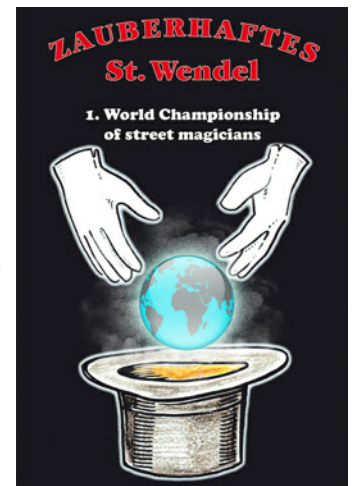
For the first time the “**World Championship of Street Magicians**” will be held. It will take place from August 27 to August 29, 2010 in St.Wendel (southwest Germany). Last year more than 30.000 spectators came to the “European Championship” in the little town St. Wendel. The winner was Charlie Caper (Sweden).

The organization admits up to 32 of the best street magicians for the **World Championship**. The criteria: dress, presentation, originality, programme and spectator reaction. Each artist has to perform in all four venues in the pedestrian area of St. Wendel. The performances should not be longer than 20 minutes. The jury consists of independent magicians and creative artists. Contrary to the championships on stage St. Wendel do not charge the participants to enter. Each magician (or group) will get a fee of 600 Euro to cover travel expenses and hotel costs. All tips will remain with the artists. The winners of the “**1st World Championship of Street Magicians**” will be awarded prizes of **1000 Euro, 800 Euro or 600 Euro**. Two more special prizes of **200 Euro** each will be awarded to the funniest performance.
